One aspect of this support is our District 11 (B.C., Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba) Quota International bursary of \$1000.00. This bursary is available to:

- Assist a person with communication disorder to receive instruction
- or -
- Assist a teacher who is willing to undertake the instruction of children with communication disorders
- or -
- Assist a person to undertake professional training for work in the field of communication disorders.

The bursary shall be paid directly to the institute of learning or upon presentation of expenses incurred for educational purposes, to the recipient. The following are also required:

- 1. A photocopy of the applicant's transcript of grades (or other certificates).
- 2. Two letters of reference from teachers or other persons who have knowledge of the applicant, attesting to previous achievements and character.
- 3. A brief autobiography including academic and extracurricular achievements and plans for future involvement in the fields of hearing and speech or communication disorders, or with the deaf community.

Application deadline is April 30th annually.
